

ST. ANTHONY-NEW BRIGHTON SCHOOLS ACCESS TO STUDENT INFORMATION BY MILITARY RECRUITERS-2019

In accordance with the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, high schools are required to release the names, addresses and telephone number(s) of students in grades 11 and 12 to military recruiters, **unless their parents have refused to release this data to military recruiting officers.** The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act protects the privacy of student education records. In addition, Minnesota State Statute 13.32 Subd. 5a MILITARY RECRUITMENT has been amended as follows: "A secondary institutions shall release to military recruiting officers the names, addresses and home telephone numbers of students in grades 11 and 12 within 60 days after the date of the request, except as otherwise provided by this subdivision. **A secondary institution shall give parents and students notice of the right to refuse release of this data to military recruiting officers.**"
